You are hereby informed that the personal data provided by contestants to participate in the contest, are necessary and mandatory to manage their participation and, as applicable, to deliver the prize.

This data will be incorporated into a file in the custody of The Malta Crafts Foundation (registered office at c/o INDIS Malta, 88, Msida Valley Road Birikirkara. BKR 1920) and used for the sole purpose of managing contest participation, communication, and prize allocation, including, as appropriate, the posting on social media and other communication channels belonging to The Malta Crafts Foundation of any information related to the cultural events organised by The Malta crafts Foundation, the control and management of the awards given, the administration of winners and participants, and the public announcement of the winners and prizes.

All actors included (Organising and Selection Committees) participating in the assessment procedure must guarantee that the privacy and confidentiality of all applications submitted in the framework of the call for proposals will be kept and that all national privacy laws and EU Directive related to the protection of personal data (95/46/EC) will be respected. It is not allowed to forward applications and assessment documents to actors outside the regular assessment procedure, project applicants or the wider public.
