Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

The event lasted 4 days including 2 days of travel and 2 days of project activities.

The activities were the following:

1. **Thematic Talks** on the legislation, the best practices and the situation of gender (in)equality in each partner's country
2. **In person guided tour** through the a.l.s.o. (non-profit organization dedicated to the integration of women and other people with difficult life situations)
3. **Thematic Workshop** on Gender Equality & Youth Involvement in Climate Justice
4. **Simulation of European Parliament**
5. **Roundtable Meeting** on gender (in)equality in politics and the European elections. How can parties build a gender equal Europe?
6. **Workshop** on the project **Podcast**

The structure, the topic discussed and the outcome of each activity are described in the Thematic Report.

A **Coordination Meeting** with all project referents took also place during the second day of activity, in parallel with the Simulation of European Parliament that was restricted to young people. The meeting covered the following topics:

1. *Communication strategy state of the art & Podcast*
Lousada, handling communication strategy, reported progress on their strategy. Faenza emphasized uploading media materials to the NEXT Google Drive for Lousada's use and highlighted some issues (e.g. YouTube channel existing but inactive, website facing indexing issues). Documents on the Podcast project structure and content were shared, with all agreeing to choose the Podcast title together later during the meeting. The structure of the workshop on the Podcast was also explained where Interviews with an expert and a young manager per theme would be conducted.
2. *Planning, organization and structure of local activities*
Faenza clarified the structure of local activities, timing, content and required number of participants. They underlined the importance of reaching the minimum number of participants indicated in the Cooperation Agreement and collecting evidence of participation of both transnational and local events realized. It was also reminded the different purposes of the Google Drive and the Padlet, especially with regards to their use for the local activities.
3. *Next Transnational Project Meeting in Daugavpils*
The Municipality of Daugavpils provided all partners with some general information about the next meeting taking place in their city and reminded all PPs to express their preference for one of the periods suggested in order to define the final dates. The content of the meeting was also discussed, including the type of expertise required.
4. *Project management*
Faenza reported progress on the project and provided some instructions about the collection of lists of participants for each event. They also reminded all PPs about the 1st Intermediate Progress Report, the Meeting Evaluation Questionnaire and the Gender Analysis Questionnaire.

The event also included a guided tour of the historic center of Schwäbisch-Gmünd and moments of conviviality such as lunches and dinners which allowed the partners to get to know each other better and exchange ideas and suggestions on the project.
